5.1 Qualifying (September 18-22, with futsal)

- a) One of the Freestyle Pom / Jazz / Hiphop or all of them
- b) Costume show
- c) Talent show (non-athletic Pom / Jazz / Hiphop etc performed in folk dance / classic stage play or other national artistic form)
- d) At least two sets of freestyle routines

5.2 Elimination series (September 24, Cheerleading only)

- a) One of the Freestyle Pom / Jazz / Hiphop
- b) Two sets of freestyle routines
- c) Captain of cheerleader's solo show

5.3 Final (September 25, with futsal final)

- a) One of the Freestyle Pom / Jazz / Hiphop
- b) Two sets of freestyle routines

5.4 Time limit

- a) Freestyle Pom / Jazz / Hiphop: 2 2.5 minutes
- b) Costume show: 2.5 3 minutes
- c) Talent show: 2.5 3 minutes
- d) Freestyle routines: 30 35 seconds
- e) Captain of cheerleader's solo show: 60 65 seconds

5.5 Requests

- a) Every team must attend the qualifying and will be distributed to one futsal team as its cheerleading members.
- b) Every team have three rounds: two in the futsal time-out in each quarter and one in the futsal half time.
- c) From September 18-20, each team has to prepare one of 2-2.5 min Freestyle Pom / Jazz / Hiphop routine and two sets of 30-35 sec freestyle routines.
- d) From September 21-22, each team has to prepare one set of talent show on 21st and one set of costume show on 22nd only.
- f) On September 24, every team has to attend the elimination series and the top four get the chance to the finals. The elimination series is only for cheerleading. In the elimination series, each team has to prepare one of the Freestyle Pom / Jazz / Hiphop routine and two sets of freestyle routines and one captain of cheerleader's solo show.
- g) On September 25, finals for the top four which will compete with the futsal finals. Each team has to prepare one of 2-2.5 min Freestyle Pom / Jazz / Hiphop routine and two sets of 30-35 sec freestyle routines. According to the score in the elimination series, the first and second place will compete

together with the futsal final, and the third and forth place will compete together with the futsal third place final.

6. Participation and Eligibility

Only competitors who meet the following conditions may take part in the event:

- a) Hold the citizenship of the country or region they represent.
- b) The player should be born from 1st January 1989 to 31st December 1999.
- c) Full-time students who are currently officially registered and pursuing a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country or region.
- d) Former students of the institutions mentioned in point "c" who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year 2016.

7. Composition of the Delegation

7.1 Futsal

- a) each member federation could send one team. A maximum of 12 teams will be accepted, among which 2 from Oceania and 10 from Asia.
- b) each team may consist of a maximum of sixteen (16) persons of which twelve (12) should be men competitors, one (1) Head of Delegation, one (1) coach, one (1) team leader or doctor and one (1) FIFA-qualified international referee.
- c) each team may enter in a maximum of twelve (12) players and a minimum of ten (10) competitors.

7.2 Cheerleading

- a) each member federation could send one team. A maximum of 12 teams will be accepted, among which 2 from Oceania and 10 from Asia.
- b) each team may consist of a maximum of sixteen (16) persons of which twelve (12) should be women competitors, one (1) Head of Delegation, one (1) team leader or doctor, one (1) international referee and one (1) coach.
- c) each team may enter in a maximum of twelve (12) players and a minimum of ten (10) competitors.

8. Financial Obligation

8.1 Participation Fee: The Organizing Committee will cover the local costs of the participating teams, including accommodation, catering and local transportation related to the training, competition and cultural program from 16 to 26 September 2017. For extra officials, the OC will charge USD60 per person per day.

8.2 AUSF Registration Fee:

USD10 per person from AUSF and FISU-Oceania members USD20 per person from non-AUSF and non-FISU-Oceania members

8.3 Costs of International Referee

The Organizing Committee will cover the local costs of the international referee. Other costs including the allowance should be covered by the team. If the international referee could not fulfill his duties during the Championship, he or she will be registered as the extra official and the costs should be covered by the teams.

8.4 Insurance

Each delegation must buy the insurance for all team members. It must cover life insurance, medical insurance, public liability, property and travel insurance, which will be checked during the accreditation upon the arrival.

9. Rules of the Competition

- **9.1** The Futsal Championship will be played in accordance with the current Laws of FIFA Futsal.
- **9.2** The Cheerleading Championship will be played in accordance with International Cheer Union (ICU) $\,$ General Safety Rules And Routine Requirements 2014 $\,$

10. Transportation

Airport: Yinchuan Hedong International Airport.

The Organizing Committee will cover the local transportation related to the training, competition and cultural program for the teams. While the international airfare to and from Yinchuan should be covered by the teams.

11. Accommodation

Western Airport Hotel Lingwu and Days Inn Zhongyin (4-star level)

12. Entries

12.1General Entry Form (G)

must be sent back no later than 10 May 2017

12.2 Quantitative Entry Form

must be sent back no later than 30 May 2017

12.3 Nominative Entry Form

must be sent back no later than 20 June 2017

12.4 Individual Entry Form (I 1, I 2)

must be sent back no later than 10 August 2017

12.5 Delegation Travel Schedule Form (N)

must be sent back no later than 10 August 2017

12.6 General Entry Form, Nominative Entry Form and Individual Entry Forms

must be sent to the OC and copied to the AUSF Secretariat.

12.7 The original copy of Individual Entry Forms (for both official and competitor) and Academic Eligibility Form (for competition only)

must be submitted upon arrival for the accreditation. If not, the teams will fail in getting the accreditation card.
